

Attention International Students Registration of Certain Nonimmigrant Aliens from Designated Countries

Effective Immediately

- The Department of Justice requires nonimmigrant aliens who meet all of the following criteria to appear before an immigration officer **on or before December 16, 2002** for registration in the National Security Entry-Exit Registration System (NSEERS):
 - Males born on or before November 15, 1986
 - Nationals or citizens of Iran, Iraq, Libya, Sudan and Syria last admitted to the U.S. on or before September 10, 2002 and will remain in the U.S. until at least December 16, 2002.
- The requirements of the Notice do not apply to the following aliens:
 - Aliens currently in A or G visa status;
 - U.S. Lawful Permanent Residents; or
 - Aliens who have applied for asylum on or before November 6, 2002 or who have been granted asylum.

Effective December 2, 2002

- The Department of Justice requires nonimmigrant aliens who meet all of the following criteria to appear before an immigration officer **on or before January 10, 2003** for registration in the National Security Entry-Exit Registration System (NSEERS):
 - Males born on or before December 2, 1986
 - Nationals or citizens of Afghanistan, Algeria, Bahrain, Eritrea, Lebanon, Morocco, North Korea, Oman, Qatar, Somalia, Tunisia, United Arab Emirates, and Yemen.
- The requirements of the Notice do not apply to the following aliens:
 - Aliens currently in A or G visa status;
 - U.S. Lawful Permanent Residents; or
 - Aliens who have applied for asylum on or before November 22, 2002 or who have been granted asylum.
